****Call date:** the board of the East Asian Growth Basket Ltd is targeting a termination date of 08 July 2027 to align to the first call date on the Investec Ltd subordinated bond. The capital recognition of the subordinated bond will reduce by 20% per annum after the first call date, making this instrument less attractive for the debt issuer as a regulatory capital instrument. However, if the debt issuer of the subordinated bond elects not to call at the first call date or on each quarterly date thereafter, (or the South African Reserve Bank or any other relevant regulator does not grant the required approval to call), then

- the investment term may be for up to 10 years after the subscription date of the Shares;
- a dividend equal to the proceeds received from the equity option (if any) will be declared by the East Asian Growth Basket Ltd on the first call date; and
- a dividend will be declared annually thereafter equal to three-month SOFR plus approximately 2.9%, up to the actual maturity date of the subordinated bond.
